Day by Day Itinerary

Sept. 12, 2012 - Day 1 Depart New York City and other gateways on an overnight flight to Europe.

Sept. 13 - Day 2 Land in Munich, Germany. We'll meet our waiting coach and guide then start the tour off right with a brief tour of the city and a mid day lunch at the world famous Hofbrau Hause in central Munich! We'll leave before the crowds get too large and continue south to Ellmau, Austria. Welcome dinner and overnight and our Tyrolean Hotel. L, D

Sept. 14 - Day 3 After a leisurely breakfast this first day, we



start a local tour of the Ellmau village. Then we'll visit the ski town of Kitzbuhl and enjoy Lunch while touring the Tyrolean Unterland. Return for local music and dinner in the village of Ellmau tonight. B,L,D

Sept. 15 - Day 4 We head toward Salzburg, the city of Mozart for a walking tour of the old town center. Then a unique ride on a lake steamer plying the Wolfgangsee in the Salzkammergut region. Enjoy the beautiful views of the surrounding mountains. Dinner and overnight in Ellmau. B, D

Sept. 16 - Day 5 We journey south via Klagenfurt and Villach, crossing the Julian Alps and into Slovenia. We'll check into our hotel near the lake edge and enjoy free time for independent sightseeing of this idyllic Alpine Lake. Dinner and overnight at our Lake Bled Hotel. B, D

Sept. 17 - Day 6 After breakfast we head to the thriving capitol city of Ljubljana. Our local expert guide will lead a sight seeing and shopping tour in the pedestrian only zone. Free time this afternoon to enjoy the welcoming city. Dinner with Music at Avsenik Gostilna in Begunje on the way back for our overnight at Lake Bled. B, D

Sept. 18 - Day 7 Today is dedicated to enjoying the green

treasure that is Triglav National Park. We'll cruise on Lake Bohinj, take a cable car ride to the top of mount Vogel with



its stunning views across to Mt. Triglav and then a rustic gostilna lunch on top of the mountain with local specialities. Overnight Lake Bled. B, D

Sept. 19 - Day 8. We head toward eastern Slovenia via the wooded valleys and river gorges of Logarska Dolina en route to the ancient town of Ptuj to tour the ethnographic museum. Then to Slovenia's second largest city, Maribor. We'll check into the Hotel Habakuk before we head to the overlooking hillsides for dinner and wine tasting to the sounds of a local button box player at the Protner Winery north of Maribor. Overnight Maribor. B, D

Sept. 20 - Day 9.

After breakfast at our spa hotel, we'll enjoy a sightseeing tour of Maribor city. Famous for its vast underground wine cellar and the world's oldest growing grape



vine, the city has much to offer. Enjoy a free afternoon strolling the streets of Maribor or head back to our fabulous hotel to make use of the world class pools, saunas and spa treatments available. Dinner and overnight Maribor. B, D

Sept. 21 - Day 10. Free time this morning to enjoy our fine Spa hotel. Then to a region near the border with Croatia to taste the famous Bizejsko Champagnes grown and bottled here. Enjoy snacks and a variety of dry sparkling wines. Back to our hotel for dinner and a chance to visit the Casino. Overnight Maribor. B, Wt, D

Sept. 22 - Day 11. Traveling through flat farmlands of the pannonian plane we head north into Austria. Turning east into the Burgenland region we check into our hotel in the town of Eisenstadt. Sightsee the city and nearby region including an entrance to the Esterhazy Castle. Enjoy a Huerigen style meal with local music and fresh wines at a local restaurant. B, D

Sept. 23 - Day 12. Take a day trip across the Danube and into western Hungary, sightseeing this gently rolling farmland region and tour the city of Sopron. We'll stop for lunch at a typical Hungarian pub featuring local specialities. Back to Austria this evening, overnight Eisenstaedt. B, L

Sept. 24 - Day 13. Enjoy a relaxing day in Eastern Austria free to explore the wonders of Burgenland. Rendezvous tonight for our farewell dinner at the Ohr restaurant in our hotel tonight in Eisenstaedt. B, D

Sept. 25 - Day 14. Early wake up as we head to the nearby Vienna Airport where we board our flight for NYC. B

Terms and Conditions

FULL PAYMENT IS DUE July 12, 2012.

1. Because airline space is limited at special group rates, we urge your deposit of U.S.D. \$300 per person as soon as possible. After all airline group space is gone, fares are subject to increase. Minimum of 20 passengers will be needed to operate this tour at the advertised price. Prices are subject to change if the Euro varies by more than 3% at time of final payment.
2. Baggage Allowance: Free airline baggage allowance is two bags per person in addition to a carry-on piece. However, the tour operator has requested that there be a limit of 1 large suitcase at 50 pounds per person due to space restrictions aboard the motorcoach and airlines weight allowances. **NO RESPONSIBILITY IS INCURRED FOR LOSS OF OR DAMAGE TO BAGGAGE OR ANY PERSONAL BELONGINGS. TRAVEL BAGGAGE INSURANCE IS RECOMMENDED AND AVAILABLE THROUGH PROFESSIONAL TRAVEL.**
3. Passport Requirements: A valid passport is required of all tour participants. A U.S. passport is valid for 10 years. Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months following your return to the United States. To apply for passports you can contact either your local passport office, Clerk of the District, or County Court. Professional Travel will be happy to help you obtain the necessary forms.
4. Tour Price Excludes: Airport Departure Taxes, customs user fees, passports, all visa fees, optional tours, telephone, telex, fax and telegram charges, excess baggage charges, sundry tips, laundry, beverages and food not on the regular table d'hôte menu (these items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), portage at U.S./Canada airports and all other items of a personal nature. Service charges at hotels and restaurants are prepaid. Travel Insurance is not included.
5. Refund and Unused or Amended Tour Arrangements: Unused hotel accommodations, tour features or services are non-refundable, nor exchangeable for other accommodations, services or features. Should there be any reason to change features of the tour for the group, any additional expenses will be charged to the tour members. If a change becomes necessary for any reason, hotels substituted will be the equivalent of those shown. Single room available at a supplemental charge.
6. Cancellation Penalties: If you cancel your reservation, your right to receive a refund is limited as set forth in the following schedules. All requests for refunds must be sent to us in writing. Charges for cancellation of the tour will be assessed by the participating airlines, tour operators, and hotels as follows:

 90-61 days prior to departure U.S. \$250 per person
 60-45 days prior to departure U.S. \$400 per person, plus air fare
 44-30 days prior to departure U.S. \$500.00 per person, plus air fare
 29 days or less prior to departure 100% Penalty and No Refund.
 Cancellation charges also apply to additional accommodations reserved prior to and after the tour.

7. Insurance. While every effort is made to ensure that baggage is properly handled and that the cancellation charges to you are kept to a minimum, Professional Travel cannot be held responsible for damages, loss or theft of luggage or personal belongings. You may secure a policy for baggage insurance, as well as insurance against sickness or accident, or trip cancellation and interruption insurance through Professional Travel.
